COMMUNITY IMPACT

For nearly 100 years, Greenleaf Family Center has been investing in the community by providing services to families and individuals who face the challenges of daily living and personal crises. In 2011, we impacted the lives of over **7,500 individuals** through 18 different programs related to issues concerning relationship and marital problems, teenage parenting, alcohol and drug addictions, financial instability and school behavioral concerns.

SERVICES

Counseling

In 2011, **2,414 individuals** were served through **9,363 hours** of counseling. Our licensed counselors provided counseling services for children, youth, adults, families, and couples on a variety of issues. Our Anger Management groups served **253 adults and adolescents**.

Financial Services for Families

Helps families and individuals become self-sufficient and move toward financial independence through an Automobile Loan Program, Credit Counseling Services, Credit Happens / Money Management Workshops, and Bankruptcy Counseling. Our Financial Services for Families programs **assisted 649 individuals** in 2011.



Community Services for the Deaf

For over 30 years, Greenleaf has provided services to deaf and hard of hearing individuals and families in our community, including: interpreters, case management, ADA information and referrals, specialized equipment loans, in-service training, advocacy and emergency services. CSD is the only program of its kind in Summit County, and serves Portage, Holmes, Wayne and Medina Counties as well.

In 2011, Greenleaf provided assistance to **2107 individuals** and completed over **3,500 hours** of interpreting services.

Family Support Programs

Parenting groups provide parents an opportunity to acquire new parenting skills and techniques, while gaining support from other parents.

Our **Teenage Parent Program** provides case management services to pregnant and parenting teens, as well as, bi-monthly support groups.

SPARK, a home-based kindergarten readiness program prepares area 3 and 4 years olds and their learning advocates for school. **The Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program** provided support and education in four different locations in Summit County. Greenleaf served over **700 individuals** through Family Support Programs in 2011.



Tri-County Employee Assistance Program

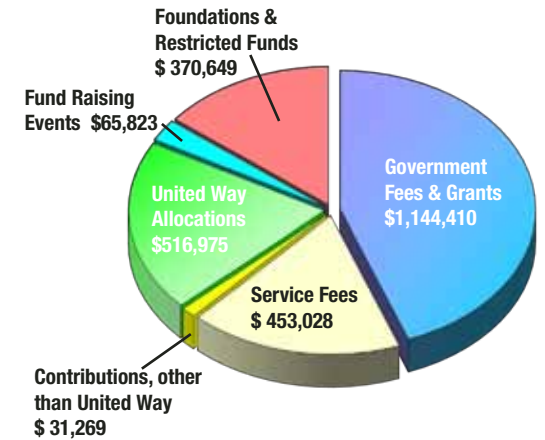

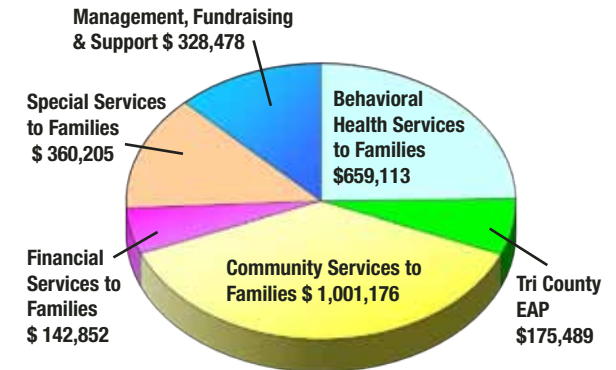
School Based Services

Include mental health counseling and anger management services in Alternative & Digital Academies and in Coventry's Turkeyfoot and Erwine Elementary Schools. Our **Anti-Bullying prevention and intervention** program works to discourage aggression, bullying and violence in area elementary and middle schools. In 2011, **811 students** were provided school based-services through Greenleaf.
